Welcome

PropShield Market Pulse is a real-time market awareness system designed for discretionary futures traders. Users choose the futures contracts they want to monitor, while Market Pulse continuously interprets market conditions in the background. It provides objective context—not trade signals—to help traders focus on the highest-quality opportunities.

Key Features

- User-defined contract watchlist using full NinjaTrader contract names.
- Background monitoring of multiple futures markets.
- Replay, Simulation, and Live compatible.
- Companion Market Pulse HUD indicator for chart display.
- Objective readings including Bias, Pressure, Intensity, Regime, Spike activity, and market context.
- Designed for discretionary trading rather than automated trade decisions.

Market Pulse HUD

After Market Pulse is running, add the Market Pulse HUD indicator to your chart. The HUD displays Market Pulse's interpretation for the chart's instrument, allowing you to minimize the main Market Pulse window and trade directly from your charts while keeping the analysis visible.

Getting Started

1. Install the PropShield Toolkit.
2. Activate your license.
3. Download and import Market Pulse.
4. Open Market Pulse from NinjaTrader.
5. Enter the contracts you want to monitor using their full NinjaTrader names.
6. Start Market Pulse.
7. Add the Market Pulse HUD indicator to your charts.
8. Confirm the chart instrument is included in the watchlist.
9. Minimize the Market Pulse window and trade using the HUD for market context.

Important Notes

Market Pulse does not generate entry or exit signals. It is intended to enhance market awareness and complement your existing trading strategy. The HUD displays Market Pulse's interpretation but does not perform its own calculations.
